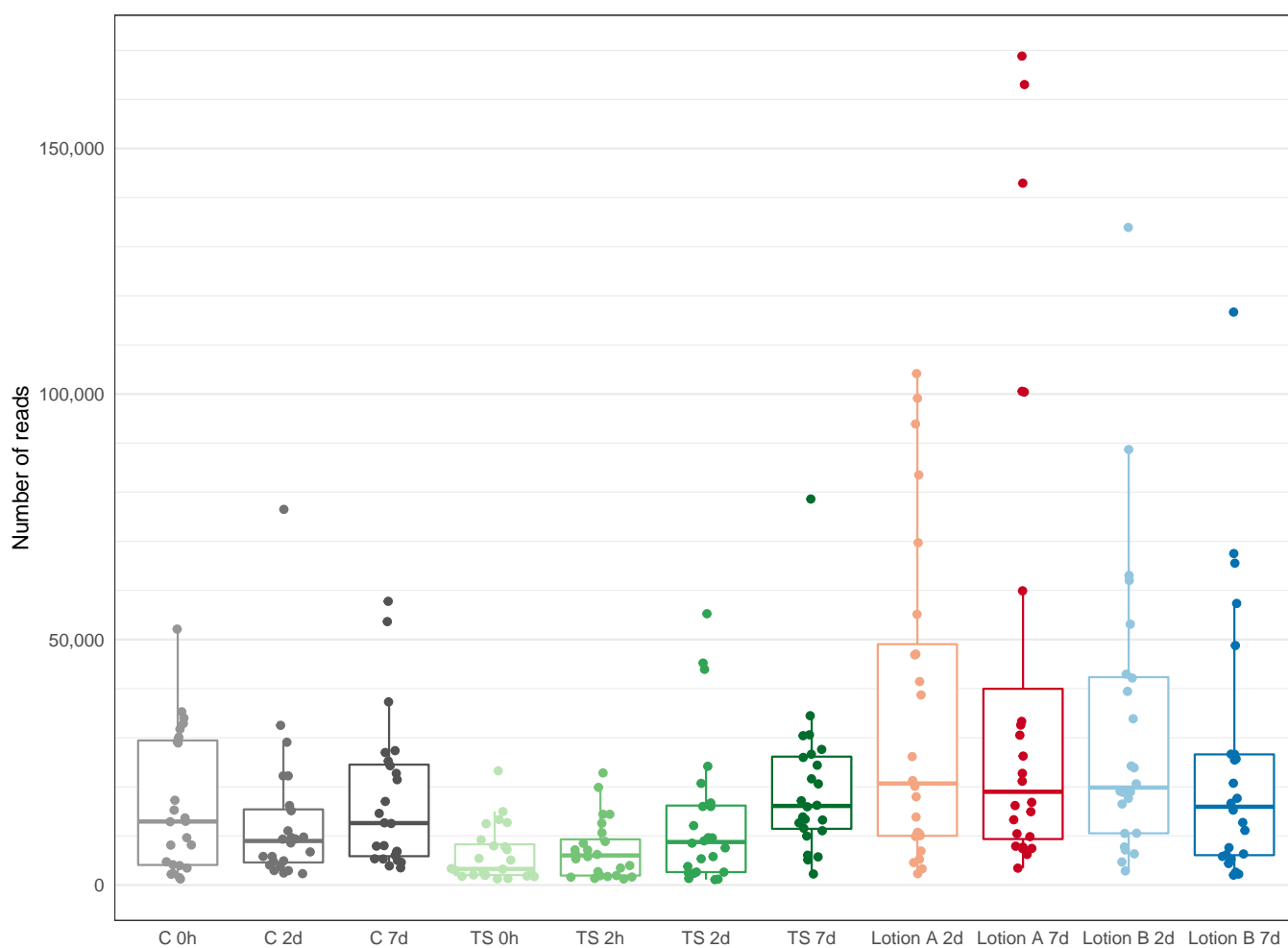


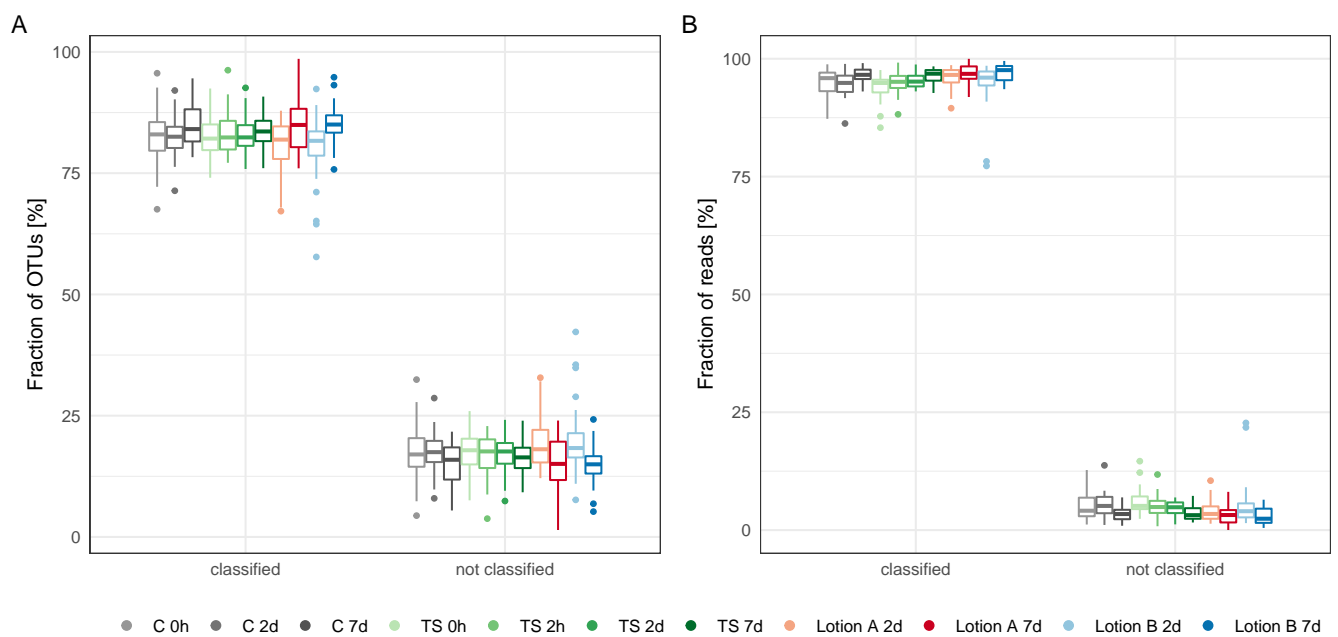

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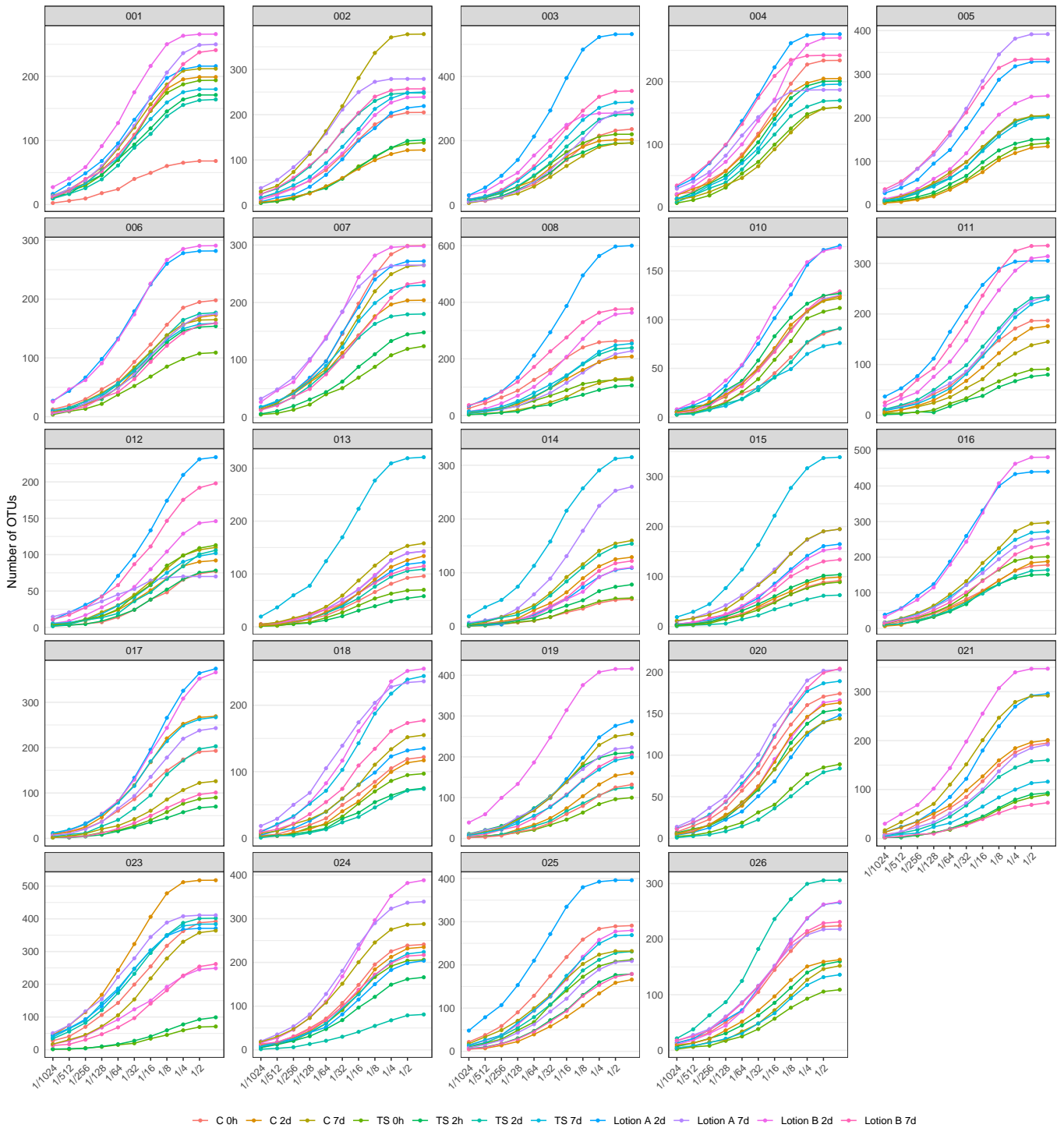

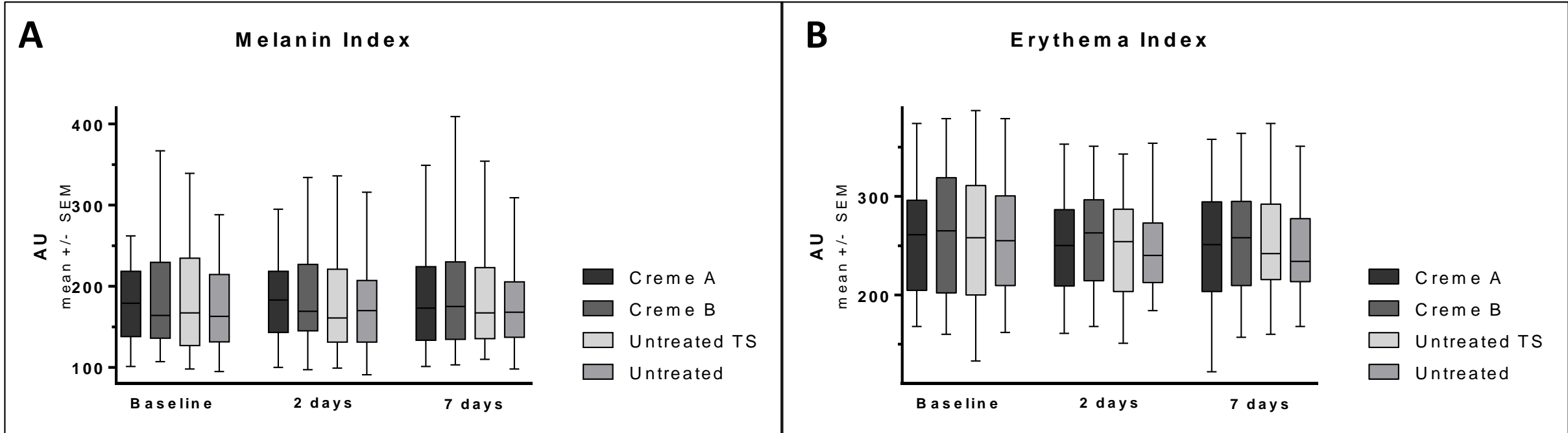
Suppl. Fig. S1: Number of reads per sample: Shown is the total number of reads that make up all OTUs per sample, separated by treatment groups.



Suppl. Fig. S2: Classification of OTUs and Reads: Shown is (A) the number of classified and unclassified OTUs and (B) the number of reads assigned to classified and unclassified OTUs, respectively.



Suppl. Fig. S3: Rarefaction analysis: Shown is the number of OTUs for the 11 samples per individual after subsampling to 1/2 read depth, 1/4 read depth and further dilutions down to 1/1024 read depth. Points show the mean of five replicates.



Suppl. Figure S4: Melanin (Panel A) and Erythema (Panel B) indices: No statistical differences were detectable.
