5. Experience and training	The researcher was supervised, oriented by two researchers with extensive experience in qualitative research, being supervisors of the medical sciences program

6. Relationship established	From the fifth semester on, the students had already had classes with the researcher
7. Participant knowledge of the interviewer	The students knew that the researcher was a teacher and was doing the master's project
8. Interviewer characteristics	There was transparency in the presentation of the research project and there was no conflict of interest

10. Sampling	All students were invited to participate
11. Method of approach	The researcher personally invited all classes to participate
12. Sample size	462 students
13. Non-participation	124 students did not participate. They were not asked about the reason for the refusal

14. Setting of data collection	The data was collected at the University
15. Presence of non-participants	Only the researcher was in the classroom

16. Description of sample	78.43% of students agreed to participate in the survey, approximately 20% of students in each semester. The average age was 22.72 years with a prevalence of female students (65.6%)
