1. Please share with me the services provided for children by private health facilities in Mbarara district? (probe for IMCI approach i.e. proper assessment of the children, classification of diseases, giving the right treatment and refer off very sick children)
2. How can the health services provided for children by low level private facilities in Mbarara district be improved? (Answers here should guide question 3)
3. What support is given to private low level health facilities for care for children in Mbarara district? Probe more on support supervision; what does it mean? I.e. the type of supervision given and Which kind of supervision)
4. Who is supporting the lower level private health facilities to improve the services for children? (probe for partners involved)
5. How often is support supervision done by the district for lower level private facilities in Mbarara district? What do you think about that frequency, it is much or little?
6. What barriers are encountered by district leadership in provision of support supervision to low level private health facilities? What has enabled (facilitated) the delivery of support supervision?
7. How best can support supervision ideally be delivered to low level private health facilities which care for children?

NB: On number 6, mentioning barriers or facilitators first will depend on the response from No. 5 i.e. if it's too little then start with barriers and vice versa.
