(Probe for IMCI i.e. appropriate assessing of the children, classification of the diseases, giving the right treatment and referral of very sick children)
2. How can the health services provided by low level private facilities in the country and Mbarara district in particular be improved? (Answers here should guide No. 3)
3. What support is given to private low level health facilities for care for children in country and Mbarara district? Probe more on support supervision; what does it mean? (probe for more on support given and which kind of supervision)
4. Who should give support to low level private health facilities to improve their services for children?
5. Who is supporting the low level private health facility to improve the services for children? ( probe for partners)
6. How often is support supervision done by the MOH for low level private facilities in general and Mbarara district? What do you think about that frequency, it is much or little?
7. What barriers are encountered by MOH leadership in provision of support supervision to low level private health facilities? What has enabled the delivery of support supervision?
8. How best can support supervision ideally be delivered to low level private health facilities which care for children?

NB: On number 6, mentioning barriers or facilitators first will depend on the response from No. 5 i.e. if it's too little then start with barriers and vice versa.
