

# Prevalence of hepatopancreatic injury and clinical outcomes in patients with COVID-19 in United States

- Retrospective analysis of 178 hospital system across USA
- 45,038 COVID-19 positive patients
- 37% White, 35% Hispanic, 22% Black
- 63% had hepatopancreatic injury
- These patients had:
  - 2.7 increased odds of more severe disease
  - 3.4 increased odds of death
  - longer hospital length of stay
  - Men had 1.37x odds of having critical vs. mild disease
  - Alcohol use associated w 1.75x odds of having critical vs. mild disease
